Revision of Standard Tender Documents


Following changes on tender documents have been made.

- (1) Civil Work Document was revised to be in line with ICTAD Standard bidding document and NPA Guidelines . Hence use the revised tender document bearing document No NWSDB/SBD/Civil/ V1 with immediate effect for contract more than SLRS 5 million. This is available at P & D section - Head Office and soft copies will be provided to all DGMM in provinces and PDD . A Guideline has also been developed to prepare this document and will be also issued.
- (2) Include provisional item with a provisional sum for price variation in General Bill
- (3) Provisional item for Construction Management Services shall not be included for contracts below 10m.
- (4) Non refundable tender fee was revised and new non refundable tender fees are given below

- (6) Standard format for Tender Evaluation Report for Supply tenders are attached herewith for implementation.
- (7) Letter of credit will be opened by NWSDB for supply contracts of value over Rs.50 million except for water meters.
- (8) New appendices on man power, machinery and equipment have been prepared to be included in Civil/M&E/Chemical equipment Tender documents. This is available in P&D Section and will be provided in a soft copy to all DGMM in Provinces/ PDD.
